Central Carroll Field Hockey program announces its Tenth Season for girls in K thru 9<sup>th</sup> grade (not playing high school) with a focus on fundamental skills, teamwork, building confidence and self-esteem.

Central Carroll Field Hockey is a member of the Maryland Youth Field Hockey League which includes recreation councils from Baltimore, Howard, Harford and Carroll Counties. Last year the program fielded ten teams. One Clinic team (K-2), Two 3-4 grade, three 5-6 grade and four 7-9 grade teams.

Practices will consist of 2 practices per week at Carroll Community college starting in mid August. Games are on Sunday afternoons starting the beginning of September. The season will run through the first week-end of November. Some travel will be required. The Clinic team will practice one evening per week and attend several half day play days.

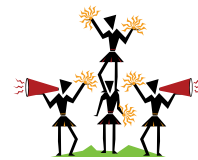

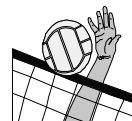
## **ADULT VOLLEYBALL**
